Summer Orienteering in South Derbyshire

Courses suitable for novices and experienced orienteers with help and advice available

Location	The Reservoir is west of Ticknall, follow the brown tourist signs.
Terrain	Varied terrain with open areas and forest. Flat areas with some steeper slopes in the south.
Car Parking	Access to the car park is through a pay barrier. £2.50 with no change given.
Post Code	DE65 6EG
Grid Ref.	SK336241
Courses	We hope to have help available for beginners and novices. Short: 2.0km White/Yellow standard Medium: 3.2km Yellow/Orange Standard Long: 4.8km Light Green Standard
Fees	Adults £4.00 Entry on the day only. Children and students £2.00 (going round on a course unaccompanied by an adult). £0.50 for a second map if you want to try another course.
Timing	The event will use Sportident electronic punching and will be enabled for touch free punching. If you do not have a Sportident card (or 'dibber') you can borrow one from registration, free of charge.
Registration	1pm to 3pm, on the day only. Look for the DVO flag.
Start	Adjacent to registration. Start times from 1pm to 3pm.
Finish	Adjacent to registration. Courses close at 4:30pm. You must report to Download even if you do not finish your course to avoid a needless search.
Facilities	Café and toilets in the car park.
Map	1:7500 with 5m contours
Dogs	Dogs are not allowed on the courses. Dogs are welcome in the area but we ask owners to keep a close control and that they should clear up any mess.
Safety	There may be nettles and brambles on some courses so full leg cover is required under British Orienteering rules, sorry no shorts. Competitors take part at their own risk. Whistles are advised.
Badges	Children over 5 can collect controls towards the British Schools Orienteering Association awards at this event, and the remaining two events in the South Derbyshire Summer Series, as well as at the National Trust events on Wednesdays 16, 23 & 30 August. To be presented at DVO's event at Kedleston Park, Sunday 24 th September (Registration open 10-12noon, awards available from 12:45) or send SAE to Rex Bleakman (see www.dvo.org.uk for details).

Membership Non-members are welcome to run at this event, but please note that British Orienteering public liability insurance covers you for three events only (as a non-member). Ask at Registration or Download for information on joining and other membership benefits.
