



Informal Orienteering Event

16 May 2015

Allestree Park

(3 Miles North of Derby off the A6)

(Courses suitable for novices and experienced orienteers with help and advice available)

Terrain: Woodland, open parkland, a lake, a hall and a golf course

Car parking and Assembly: Off the A6 (Derby – Matlock) Long Driveway to the Main Car Park. Registration will be signposted with Event Staff on hand.

Courses: Yellow, Orange & Light Green

Entries and fees: Entry on the day only.

Adults £3.00

Children and Students: £1.50

Timing: The event will use Sportident electronic punching. If you do not have a Sportident card, you can hire one free at Registration.

Registration on the day only: 10.00 am until 11:00.

Start Times: From 10.30 am to 11:30. The start and finish are 100 Metres from Registration

Courses close at 13:00. You must report to Download even if you retire to avoid a needless search.

Toilets: There are toilets available at the Main Hall GR SK346406 (Some 250metres from Registration)

Parking: Parking is Free. There are a number of Car Parks dotted around Allestree with the Main one closest to Registration.

Map: All courses will use scale 1:7,500 with 5m contours

Dogs: These are allowed on the Park but must be kept under control at all times and any poo removed. Dogs are not allowed on courses.

Safety: Allestree Park is a Local (to Derby) Country Park and Nature Reserve with numerous facilities available if the weather is fine the park is likely to be busy with Families (Including Dogs), Walkers, Runners, Cyclist and Golfers, please be vigilant in and around the area and be considerate to other park users at all times.

The nearest A & E is 5 miles from the park at Royal Derby Hospital, Uttoxeter Rd, Mickleover, Derby. DE22 3NE

It must be emphasized that straying onto the Golf Links could result in an accident and raise complaints against further use of this facility and therefore Competitors are requested to be extra careful not to stray onto them
