



## Informal Orienteering Event

**Derby College – Broomfield Hall**  
3.5 Miles from the Pentagon Island A52

(Courses suitable for novices and experienced orienteers with help and advice available)

**Terrain:** Open farmland, with tracks, footpaths & areas of woodland

**Car parking and Assembly:** Derby College – Broomfield Hall. Main entrance off the A608 (Note do NOT use the Equestrian Centre Entrance). Car Parking is free.

Please note: Broomfield Hall has a speed limit of 5 mph. Due to the nature of the site there could possibly students tending to animals in the Animal Centre and horses being exercised in and around the Equestrian Centre.

**Courses:** White, Yellow, Orange, Light Green

**Entries and fees:** Entry on the day only.

**Adults** £3.00

**Children and Students:** £1.50

**Timing:** The event will use Sportident electronic punching. If you do not have a Sportident card, you can hire one free at Registration.

**Registration on the day only:** 10.00 am until 11:30.

**Start Times:** From 10.30 am to 12 noon. The start and finish are adjacent to registration.

**Courses close at 13:00.** You must report to Download even if you retire to avoid a needless search.

**Toilets:** Situated in the Sport Hall, where changing rooms and showers are available

**Map:** 1:5,000, 5m contours. Mike Godfree 2011. Updated 2014

**Dogs:** Dogs are allowed on site but not on the courses.

Derby College has an Animal Care Centre. With sufficient notice you may be able to book your dog in for grooming whilst you are out on the course!

All Competitors are to note that Broomfield Hall is a working farm site and that there may be farm animals present in the fields crossed by your course. Where possible the courses will not require you to run directly across fields that have farm animals in however, if there are animals present, simply take a safe route around the edge of the field.

**Safety:** Although it is open farmland there will be areas where shorts are not suitable, and therefore ALL competitors are asked to wear full leg cover
